CHAPTER ONE PREAMBLE

1. PREAMBLE

The Karnataka State Cricket Association (hereinafter referred to as the "Association" in brief) is vested with rights / ownership in a series of land and buildings, including cricket Stadiums across the state. The main facility being at M. Chinnaswamy Stadium is located at the junction of Mahatma Gandhi Road and Queens Road behind the Mahatma Gandhi Park at Bengaluru. Pursuant to the decision taken at the General Body, the Association is desirous to continue providing certain recreational and other facilities within its premises, for the use of Cricketers, players, members of the Association and cricket fans including women and the physically challenged.

WHEREAS, in line with the powers vested under Rule 15B (xxi) read with Rule 25E(a) of the Karnataka State Cricket Association by-laws, the Managing Committee of the Association has resolved to form a Sub-Committee, in the name and style of "Bangalore Sports Centre" Sub-committee, to carry out these objects of the Association.

WHEREAS, in the interest of administrative convenience, it is desired to locate the Office of the "Bangalore Sports Centre" at the Members Pavilion in the Stadium, which is ideally situated for the said purpose. The Managing Committee of the Karnataka State Cricket Association has passed an appropriate resolution confirming the same and has prescribed the following rules that are to govern the functioning of the Sports Centre.

CHAPTER TWO SCOPE

2. **DEFINITIONS**

Terms and phrases defined hereunder shall govern the interpretation of the provisions of these by-laws. Unless the context otherwise requires, terms that are not specifically defined herein shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the KSCA By-law.

Interpretation – In case of any ambiguity, KSCA Managing Committee shall have the powers to interpret any provisions of these rules based on convention.

- a) "Area" Shall mean, whole of Karnataka State as defined in Rule 3 of the KSCA byelaws.
- b) "Bangalore Sports Centre" shall mean the "Sports centre" sub-committee formed by KSCA covering the "local area" as defined hereunder.
- c) "Club House", shall mean the erstwhile KSCA CLUB HOUSE as it stood before it was renamed as "KSCA Bangalore Sports Centre".
- d) "Cricket fan" shall mean a person genuinely passionate about cricket and can demonstrate his commitment towards cricket to the Managing Committee of KSCA.
- e) "Committee" Committee shall mean Executive Committee
- f) "Sub-Committee" shall mean the Sub Committee appointed by the 'Executive Committee', Bangalore Sports Centre for various sections and other purposes for efficient functioning of the Sports Centre.

g) "Dependent" means

- i. Widowed mother of the member;
- ii. Dependant Sons below the age 25 Years; and
- iii. Unmarried Daughters without independent means of livelihood.
- h) "Executive Committee" shall mean the committee of the Bangalore Sports Centre constituted as per Rule 12 of the present by-laws of the sports centre.
- i) "IA" wherever used shall refer to the "Institutional Associate" of KSCA and shall mean as per rule 3A(b) of KSCA byelaws;
- j) "IM" wherever used shall refer to the "Institutional Member" of KSCA and shall mean as per rule 3(e) of KSCA byelaws;
- k) "KSCA" shall mean Karnataka State Cricket Association®.
- 1) "Local Area": Local area shall mean the limits of the Corporation of the City of Bangalore and shall extend to cover the areas that falls within "Bangalore zone" as defined from time to time under the KSCA by-laws.
- m) "Member/s" Members shall mean all categories of Members of the Bangalore Sports Centre and shall include both male and female members.
- n) "Office-Bearers" Office Bearers shall mean the office bearers as defined under Rule 1 (A) (cc) of the KSCA bylaws and for the purposes of these Rules shall include the Assistant Secretary, Bangalore Sports Centre.
- o) "Resident Members" shall mean and include those who reside within 100 miles of the Corporation limits of the City Corporation of Bangalore.

- p) 'Rules': Rules shall mean the Rules, Regulations and Bylaw of the Bangalore Sports Centre for the time being in force framed by the KSCA and the rules of the KSCA bye laws.
- q) **"Sports Centre"** shall mean the sub-committee formed by KSCA in terms of Clause 4(t) of the Memorandum of Association of KSCA, read with Rule 15 B (xxi) of KSCA By-law.
- r) "Year": Year shall mean the year commencing from 1st April of one calendar year and shall extend up to 31st March of the following year.

CHAPTER THREE MEMBERSHIP AND PRIVILEGES

On approval by the KSCA Managing Committee, membership to the "KSCA - Bangalore Sports Centre", shall be open only to persons above the age of 21 years and if such person belongs to one of the following categories:

3. CATEGORY OF MEMBERS:

The members of the Bangalore sports Centre shall be categorised as

(a) CHIEF PATRONS:

The Chief Patron of KSCA shall be the Chief Patron of the Bangalore Sports Centre.

(b) PATRONS:

Such of those persons who are invited by the Managing Committee of the Karnataka State Cricket Association as Patrons of the Association shall also be Patrons of the Bangalore Sports Centre.

(c) LIFE MEMBERS:

Any member who was a Life Member of the KSCA Club House as on 31.12.1999and is an eligible member in terms of the rules as they existed as on that date, such member will be eligible to continue as a Life Member of the Bangalore Sports Centre till his or her death, resignation or transfer. No new Life Member be enrolled on and from 01-01-2000.

(d) ORDINARY MEMBERS:

"Ordinary Members" of the Sports - Centre shall comprise of:

i. Life Members, Associates, Cricketer Associates, Stand Donor Associates of KSCA;

Provided, each person under any of the above categories can choose to become member only in any one of the Sports Centres run by KSCA.

ii. President or Secretary of Founder Institutional Members of (KSCA) who have not nominated any person to the membership of erstwhile Club House or any of the Sports Centres of KSCA in any location, subject to the condition that;

the President or Secretary of Founder Institutional Member, who are conferred membership of the Bangalore Sports Centre, shall lose their membership of the said Sports Centre if,

- a) Such Founder Institutional member does not renew his or her primary membership in KSCA, in accordance with the rules of KSCA; or
- b) The President or Secretary individually cease to be the President or Secretary of the said Founder Institutional Member, respectively; or
- c) The President or Secretary obtain membership of any other Sports Centre of KSCA or nominate any other person for membership of any of the other sports centres of KSCA.

(e) SPECIAL MEMBERS:

Subject to the maximum limit as prescribed hereunder, the following categories of persons, may be enrolled by the Managing Committee of KSCA as Special Members and shall pay admission fee and a monthly subscription fee as prescribed in these Rules:

i. A Cricketer who has played for KSCA in the National Championship for the Ranji Trophy / or

- any senior state tournament conducted by the BCCI;
- ii. A cricketer permanently residing in a local area and has played for India in an official / unofficial Test Match in or outside India, or
- iii. Umpire of the KSCA who is on the Ranji Panel or Test Panel of Umpires and has umpired for a minimum of 5(five) matches;
- iv. Nominees, being the son / daughter of Life Members of KSCA and Associates of KSCA, as per Rule 7(a) hereunder;
- v. Honorary Life Members of KSCA,
- vi. Ranji Trophy Players hailing from Karnataka irrespective of number of matches played and irrespective of the State they have represented;
- vii. Distinguished persons, including International sports persons of other disciplines, other than cricket, as recommended by the Managing Committee of KSCA:
- viii.Honorary Member of the KSCA Bangalore Sports Centre,
- ix. Nominees of the Founder Institutional Members and Institutional Associates;

provided that the President or Secretary of that IM/IA have not taken membership of any of the Sports Centres run by KSCA.

Further provided that, such nominees of Founder Institutional Members and Institutional Associates shall lose their membership of the Bangalore Sports Centre if the Founder Institutional Members or Institutional Associates do not renew the membership of KSCA in accordance with the rules of KSCA.

x. Ranji Cricketers of other States.

Provided that, each person under any of the above categories can choose to become member only in any one of the Sports Centres run by KSCA.

Once admitted to the membership of the Sports Centre, such special member(s) shall, during validity period of their membership, enjoy all rights and facilities of the membership of the Bangalore Sports Centre subject to the rules prescribed.

(f) CASUAL MEMBERS:

Any person taking part in any sporting event of International or National repute, and is stationed / visiting the premises of the KSCA, may be enrolled by the Managing Committee of the KSCA as a Casual Member of the Bangalore Sports Centre for the duration of the event, subject to payment of the subscription fee as prescribed, if any.

(g) MEMBERS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE AND SUB-COMMITTEES OF KSCA:

- i. All Members of the Managing Committee of the Karnataka State Cricket Association may be enrolled as "members of the Bangalore Sports Centre". Their membership of the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be co-terminus with their term on the managing committee.
- ii. Subject to the recommendation of the Managing Committee of KSCA, any member of any Sub-Committee of KSCA, may be enrolled as Members of the Bangalore Sports Centre. Such membership

shall be co-terminus with their term as KSCA subcommittee members.

However, recommending any sub-committee member of KSCA for membership to the Bangalore Sports Centre, shall be at the discretion of the Managing Committee of the Association.

iii. Enrollment of members under this category shall be subject to payment of "admission fee" as prescribed and such of those members enrolled shall be entitled to enjoy all privileges of the Bangalore Sports Centre on payment of applicable "subscription fee" as mentioned / prescribed and shall be bound by the Rules and by-laws of the Bangalore Sports Centre.

Provided, each person under any of the above categories shall be given option to hold membership only in any one of the Sports Centres run by KSCA until they remain members of the respective Managing Committee/Sub-committee.

(h) HONORARY MEMBERS:

Person(s) of eminence may be invited by the Managing Committee of KSCA to be Honorary Members of the Sports Centre, however the maximum number of such membership that can be given by the Managing committee shall be limited to fifteen during the term of that respective managing committee. The tenure of that membership shall be for a maximum of two years renewable for one more term of two years, however such membership shall be valid until the term of such managing committee giving the membership.

(i) LONG TERM TEMPORARY MEMBERS:

The Long-Term temporary members (LTTM) shall be as defined in Rule No.Rule 8 hereunder.

(j) NOMINEES OF CORPORATE DONORS/ SPONSORS OF KSCA ACTIVITIES:

The Nominees of Corporate donors / Sponsors of KSCA shall be enrolled as members as per Rule No.9 hereunder.

(k) **SERVICE MEMBRS**:

- (1) The following persons may be enrolled as "service members" subject to the rules as prescribed:
 - (i) Any person who is in service of the Central or State Government as an Officer,
 - (ii) Persons who are holding office in organizations such as Railways, Airlines, Armed Forces, City Corporation who live in the revenue district of Bangalore;
 - (iii) Senior representative of the Government like Legislators etc., at the discretion of the Managing Committee; in accordance with the rules framed from time to time;
- (2) Members enrolled as service members shall pay the non-refundable admission fee as mentioned in Rule 11(A), and shall be entitled to use the facilities of the Bangalore Sports Centre subject to payment of applicable subscriptions as prescribed in the Rule 11(B).
- (3) Members under this category shall not have "right to vote" in the elections of the sub-committee nor shall they have the right to contest for any post as an office bearer in the executive committee;
- (4) Term of service membership and renewal:
 - i. The term of members enrolled under this category shall be a period of 2 (two) years;

- ii. In addition to the original term, Service Membership can be renewed for a further period of one term. The admission fee shall be as applicable to that of new Service Member and the subscription shall be paid for the renewed term as per Rule 11(A) and 11(B).
- iii. If the application for renewal is made before six months from the proposed date of expiry of membership, the HonrarySecretary can renew the said membership and then place it before the Managing Committee in the next meeting, for ratification.
- iv. In case, where the application for renewal has been made after a gap of six months from the date of expiry of membership, then the member has to obtain a fresh application form and shall comply with the applicable procedures as per the admission rules.
- v. If a member under this category ceases to be a member at any point of time or after the expiry of four years (two terms), he/she shall not be eligible for membership under this category again, unless there is a cooling off period of one year from the date of such cessation of membership.
- (5) A refundable deposit of Rs.10,000/- shall be collected.

(I) TEMPORARY MEMBERS:

A person who is a resident in the Residential Rooms of Bangalore Sports Centre shall be enrolled as a "Temporary Member" and such membership shall be limited to the period of his / her stay in the residential rooms. The prescribed fee / subscription as provided in

Rule Rule 11(A) and 11(B).shall be paid by such member for being eligible to enjoy the privileges of the Bangalore Sports Centre.

(m) SHORT TERM TEMPORARY MEMBERS:

Any person who is not a resident of Bangalore and intends to use the club facility for a maximum period of three months can become a Short-Term Temporary Member (STTM). The admission to membership under this category shall be at the discretion of the Committee consisting of President, Honorary Secretary, Chairman of the Bangalore Sports Centre and Assistant Secretary of the Bangalore Sports Centre. The list of such members enrolled, if any, shall be placed before the Managing Committee in the succeeding meeting. No person can be made a member under this class for more than one term in a calendar year. There shall be at least nine months gap between two terms.

4. LIMIT ON NUMBER OF MEMBERS:

(a) The membership to the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be limited to 7,450, covering all categories of membership envisaged above. The total number of members under each category, shall be further restricted to the maximum number as indicated in column (c) of the table below:

Note:

- (1) For the limited purpose of determining the maximum limit of number of members, (a) Chief Patron; (b) Patrons; (c) Ordinary Members; (d) Members of Managing Committee of KSCA and Members of the Sub-Committees of KSCA constituted by the Managing Committee of KSCA; shall be clubbed and grouped under the heading "Ordinary Members".
- (2) President / Secretary of Institutional Member (IM) of KSCA shall be grouped under "*Ordinary Members*" and a separate allocation of 350 vacancies shall be set aside for such membership applications. Memberships already granted to such Presidents / Secretaries of IMs shall be reckoned with in this cap.
- (3) Further, LIFE MEMBERS of KSCA, who have not availed membership of the Club house / Bangalore sports centre, shall be considered for membership of Bangalore Sports centre immediately on applying, without waiting period under the "Ordinary Members" category, irrespective of the availability of vacancies. Any increase in the limit due to such memberships granted by the Managing Committee shall be ratified and regularised in the immediately following Annual General Body meeting of KSCA.
- (b) All the members of the erstwhile "KSCA Club House", who were on rolls of KSCA club house as on 18th Sep. 2018 shall be deemed to be the members of the "Bangalore Sports Centre" under the respective category under which they were given the membership of the KSCA Club House.
- (c) No new "Life Members" shall be enrolled for the "Bangalore Sports centre". Further, as and when there is a reduction in the numbers in the "life Members" category, on account of death/resignation/transfer, the equivalent number shall be added to the category of "Ordinary

Members" and the limit of that category shall be increased proportionately without effecting increase in the overall limit of the number of members.

(d) If the prescribed number of memberships is reached, the Committee shall place the applications for membership on a waiting list and maintain a register of such applications in a chronological order. The application for membership of every person shall be placed before the Committee when a vacancy occurs. If the application is rejected, the applicant and the proposer shall be informed accordingly without assigning any reason and the decision of the Committee shall be final in this regard.

5. CLASS OF MEMBERS AND ELIGIBLITY

The privileges of the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be open and be available for use by the following category of persons, who are enrolled as members of the "Bangalore Sports Centre", subject to payment of applicable Admission fee and subscriptions:

- a. Life Members of KSCA
- b. Associates of KSCA
- c. Cricketer Associates of KSCA
- d. Stand Donor Associates of KSCA
- e. Nominees of Founder Institutional Members as per Rule 7(b).
- f. Nominees of Institutional Associates as per Rule 7(b).
- g. Honorary Life Members of KSCA
- h. "Ranji/State Cricketers:
 - i. Players who have represented Karnataka in Ranji Trophy Championship or any senior state tournament conducted by the BCCI.

- ii. Ranji Trophy Players who have represented any other state than the State of Karnataka, who have played at least 25 Ranji matches and are settled in the "local area".
- i. Umpires of KSCA on Ranji Panel and Test Panel who have officiated a minimum of five Ranji Matches.
- j. Cricketers who have represented India in Official/ Unofficial Tests and are permanently residing in the local area.
- k. Distinguished persons including International Sports person of other disciplines other than cricket and who the KSCA Managing Committee recommends.
- 1. Service Members who are eligible as per Rule 4 (k).
- m. Nominees, being son / daughter of Life Members of KSCA and Associates of KSCA as laid out in Rule 7(a).
- n. Honorary Member of the Bangalore Sports Centre.
- o. Long Term Temporary Members being eligible as per Rule 8.
- p. Members of the Managing Committee of KSCA and Members of the Sub-Committees of KSCA recommended by the Managing Committee of KSCA.
- q. Short Term Temporary Members being eligible as per Rule 3(A)(m).
- r. President or Secretary of Founder Institutional Members as per the rules and records of KSCA

6. OTHER PROVISIONS WITH REGARDS TO MEMBERS

(a) GUESTS: -No non-members shall be admitted or shall be permitted to use the facilities / privileges of the Bangalore Sports Centre in the normal course unless such person is introduced as a "guest of members" and accompanied by a member.

The privileges of the Bangalore Sports Centre, shall be available for use for the "Guests of the member/s" subject to the following conditions

- i. A Member may introduce not more than four persons to the Club as his guests at a time.
- ii. Affiliated Club Members are not entitled to introduce any guests.
- iii. Guest fee Every member introducing a guest shall pay guest charges at **Rs.50/-** per guest on week days (Monday to Thursday) and **Rs.100/-** on Friday, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.

However, this rule shall not apply to parties arranged by members in designated party halls and when members bring guests on occasions when the Bangalore Sports Centre expressly authorizes the members to do so.

- iv. The affiliated Club Members using sports centre facilities shall pay charges for use by them as applicable to guests of members prescribed above.
- v. Members are required to voluntarily sign the Guest Registers placed at the entrance/s. If, the Guests are not registered at the entrance, the Guest Book will be taken to the table for registration and in such circumstances, the charges will be **Rs. 100/-** on week days (Monday to Thursday) and **Rs. 200/-** on Friday, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays or as may be fixed from time to time.
- vi. The guest fee as prescribed shall be exclusive of the charges / fees that may be fixed specifically for each guest for entry / participation in any event or games or charges for use of any section of the sports centre.

- vii. Every member introducing a guest, shall be responsible for his compliance of the rules of the Sports Centre. Where the introduction or presence of guest/s is objected to by any member or any reasonable ground the matter shall be referred to the Assistant Secretary of Bangalore Sports Centre, The Chairman or Hon Secretary of KSCA, Hon Treasurer or the person authorized and the decision taken by them shall be final. No member will introduce as his guest, a resident of Bangalore more than **thrice a month** and a non-resident more than **Ten days a month**.
- viii. No resident or non-resident of Bangalore can come as a guest of any member more than the number of times in aggregate as prescribed in (vii) above;
- ix. Every member introducing a guest shall enter his guests full name and address together with his own name and membership number in the guest register at the Reception Counter before taking the guest inside. This rule is applicable to all sections of the Club.

(b) PARTYHALLS:-

- i. The Bangalore Sports Executive Committee shall have power to make the Bangalore Sports Centre premises or a portion of it available for use for special functions organized by a "permanent member" on such terms and conditions as may be decided upon by them.
 - Note:- "permanent member" shall include Life member, Ordinary member, special members, LTTM, Corporate Donor/ Sponsors, Service Members and Honorary Members.
- ii. Each member shall be entitled to use the party halls / host parties only upto a maximum of 12 times in a calendar year.

- (c) **DEPENDENTS:** The dependants of Members are not permitted to bring guests to the Sports centre and dependent children are not allowed to stay in the Sports Centre premises, after 9.00 p.m. unless they are accompanied by either of their parents. Dependant/Members should possess Identity Cards and must make them available for inspection as and when demanded by authorised personnel.
- (d) GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL: A Member aggrieved by a decision of the Executive Committee shall have a right of appeal to the Managing Committee of KSCA. The decision of the Managing committee shall be final and binding on the parties. No person, including a member of the Sports Centre, shall have the right of recourse to a court of law on any aspect governed by the Rules and By-law of the Association.

7. NOMINATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

(a) Nominees of Life Members of KSCA and Associates of KSCA:

Any life member or Associate of KSCA shall have a right to nominate his son or daughter to become the member of Bangalore Sports Centre, subject to the condition that:

- the first such nomination is made after completing being member for 20 (Twenty) years in KSCA and 10 (Ten) years as member in the "KSCA Club House / Bangalore Sports Centre";
- ii. the second such nomination is made after completing 25 years as member in KSCA and 20 years in Club House/Bangalore Sports Centre.

Provided the application for second such nomination is made after a gap of three years after the application for first nomination has been accepted by the Managing Committee. Note: - For the purpose of this clause

For reckoning the period of membership in KSCA Club House / Bangalore Sports Centre, member ship under the categories of Life / Ordinary / Special shall be cumulatively considered.

(b) Nominees of the Founder Institutional Members and Institutional Associates of KSCA:

Subject, to the conditions and restrictions as set out in clause (iii), hereunder,

- i. Founder Institutional Member and Institutional Associates may recommend not more than one member of their Institution for the membership of the Bangalore Sports centre, provided that:
 - 1. Institutional Associates who have enrolled after 30-10-2000 are entitled to nominate one person to the Sports Centre only on completion of fifteen years as Institutional Associates and subject to their active participation in cricket activities of KSCA during such period.
 - 2. No change of nominee is permitted until the expiry of two years from the date of nomination of a nominee member.
 - 3. Where a nominee member is changed after the expiry of two years, the new member as may be nominated by the respective Institutional Member and approved by the Managing Committee of KSCA shall pay the fee of Rs.35,000/- (Rupees Thirty-Five Thousand only) for change of nominee.
 - 4. They shall also clear dues, if any, of the previous representative of the said Club/Institution.

ii. The Presidents & Secretaries of Outstation Institutional Members of KSCA are entitled to use the Bangalore Sports Centre facility in accordance with the by-law of the Sports Centre, provided such Founder Institutional Members are not residents of "local area" and have also not nominated any person to the membership of sports centre and their Club/Institution should also be participating in the league and other tournaments conducted by the Association in the respective zones.

Such President / Secretary of the Outstation Institutional member, who are nominated by the respective clubs and approved by the Managing Committee of KSCA, shall pay no admission fees and temporary identity cards will be issued to the Presidents or the Secretaries for a period not exceeding one year to enable them to use the facilities of Sports Centre. If the president/Secretary is interested in continuing the membership, the same may be applied for afresh. The President/Secretary is not entitled to use the facilities for more than five days in a month and the necessary charges for the usage shall be paid by him/them. They will have no right of voting or contesting in any election.

iii. The President or Secretary of Founder Institutional Members of KSCA are eligible to become Ordinary Member of the Bangalore Sports Centre, provided, such Founder Institutional Member has not nominated any person to the membership of Club House/Sports centre.

Provided that, persons like Chairman, Vice Chairman, Vice President, executive Secretary or other designations used by the Founder Institutional Members shall also be eligible provided., they have

been mentioned as the authorized persons in the records maintained as per the KSCA rules.

Provided, further such person shall remain as Ordinary Member of the Sports Centre as long as they are President or Secretary of the Founder Institutional Member and shall automatically cease to be an Ordinary Member of the Sports Centre once they demit the office of the President or Secretary of the Founder Institutional Member.

It is expressly stated that such of those Founder Institutional Members who have nominated other than the President or Secretary for the membership of Sports Centre are not entitled for the category of Membership, until the earlier nomination is withdrawn.

8. LONG-TERM TEMPORARY MEMBERS:

(a) Senior Officer of the Government not below the grade of Deputy Secretary, Senior Administrative or Technical or Executive Officers of any industry, public or private, Senior Managers of Nationalized or Private Sector Banks, Doctors of Hospitals, Government or Private not below the rank of Assistant Professors, Police Officers not below the rank of Assistant Commissioner of Police who by virtue of their duties are temporarily stationed in Bangalore and are liable to transfer may be enrolled as Long Term Temporary Members at the discretion of the Managing Committee, in accordance with the rules framed from time to time and on payment of non-refundable admission fees as mentioned in Rule 11(A) and 11(B). Their membership shall not be for a period exceeding 3 (three) years, continuously. Also, they have to pay the monthly subscription as per Rule 11(A) in advance for the full period of three years. They will not have any voting right nor shall have rights to contest any election, especially for the Executive Committee.

- (b) Such Long-term temporary members shall pay a refundable deposit of Rs.10,000/-.
- (c) In addition to the original term, the Long-Term Temporary Membership can be renewed for a further period of one term. The admission fee shall be as applicable to that of new Long-Term Temporary Members and the subscription shall be paid for the renewed term as per Rule 11(A) and 11(B).
- (d) If the application for renewal is made before six months from the proposed date of expiry of membership, the Hon Secretary can renew the said membership and then place it before the Managing Committee in the next meeting, for ratification.
- (e) In case, where the application for renewal has been made after a gap of six months from the date of expiry of membership, then the member has to obtain fresh application form and shall comply with all procedures as per admission rules.
- (f) If a member under this category ceases to be a member at any time after being a member, or after expiry of Six years (two terms) period of membership, he/she shall not be eligible for membership under this category again, unless he / she has undergone the cooling off period of one year from the date of such cessation of membership.

9. NOMINEES OF CORPORATE DONORS / SPONSORS OF KSCA:

As per the provisions of Rule 3B(H) of amended KSCA bylaws, managing committee of KSCA is empowered to admit certain category of institutions to be the "CORPORATE DONORS" of KSCA for a limited period based on the amount paid / contributed by such institution. As per the said provisions, managing committee is also empowered to extent the benefit to such "CORPORATE DONORS" to nominate any three of their senior executives to use the privileges of Bangalore Sports Centres run by KSCA at any given point of time during the validity of such Donor ship accorded by KSCA. Such of those CORPORATE DONORS as approved by the KSCA managing committee shall be governed by the following rules:

- (a) Each such "CORPORATE DONOR" on approval by the KSCA managing committee shall be entitled to nominate 3 (three) of their senior executives to use the facilities and privileges of the Bangalore Sports Centre.
- (b) The persons so nominated have to be senior executives of the Corporate Donor's undertaking and their nomination is subject to approval by the KSCA managing committee.
- (c) The privileges of nomination and / membership shall be available from the date of approval of their "corporate donor" ship in KSCA and shall be valid for the period specified herein below

Sl.No	Amount	Period
1	Rs.15 Lakhs	15 Years or till the validity of "donor ship" period in KSCA, whichever is earlier
2	Rs.10 Lakhs	9 Years or till the validity of "donor ship" period in KSCA, whichever is earlier
3	Rs.5 Lakhs	4 Years or till the validity of "donor ship" period in KSCA, whichever is earlier

- (d) Such nominees of the CORPORATE DONORS shall have no right to vote or contest for any elections of the Bangalore Sports Centre.
- (e) Similarly, any person/nominee of institutions who has/ have sponsored for the development of cricket and as approved

by the Managing Committee of KSCA may be admitted to use the facilities of the Sports Centre. The privilege to use the facility is co-terminus with the duration of sponsorship. They will have no right of voting nor shall they be eligible to contest any election.

10. ADMISSION, TRANSFER, TERMINATION AND RESIGNATION

(A) ADMISSION: -

- (a) Application for admission shall be made in writing in the prescribed form, accompanied by payment of prescribed admission / Registration fees.
- (b) The application shall be duly proposed by Life Member or Ordinary member or Special member of KSCA Bangalore Sports Centre and seconded by Life Members or Ordinary Members or Special Members of the KSCA Sports Centre as set out in **Schedule I.**
- (c) A Life Member or Ordinary Member of Special member of KSCA Bangalore Sports Centre can propose only for one person between 1st of April and 31st of March of any financial year. Similarly, a Life Member or Ordinary Member or Special Member of KSCA Sports Centre can second only one person between 1st of April and 31st of March of any financial year.
- (d) The admission to membership of KSCA Bangalore Sports Centre shall be given only with the approval of the Managing Committee of KSCA.
- (e) All classes of membership commence and / shall deem to commence from the date of approval by the Managing Committee of KSCA, as the case may be.
- (f) Any cessation of membership arising by virtue of demise, resignation or expulsion of nominee of IM /

IA, shall be filled in by such IM/IA as per the provisions of their respective constituent document. Provided, however, the new member pays the registration fees for the membership prevailing at that time within the specified time and non-presentation of bills or demands in respect thereof by the Centre authorities shall not be considered as an excuse for delay in payment or non-payment thereof.

(g) If any member who has voluntarily resigned his membership of the Sports Centre wishes to re-join, he may be proposed as a New Member provided he has discharged all his liabilities to the Sports Centre. His application however, shall be deemed as fresh proposal for membership of the Sports Centre and he / she shall pay the then prevailing fees.

(B) TRANSFER: -

The membership in the Bangalore Sports Centre shall <u>not be</u> transferable, excepting those coming under the following categories

- i) Rule 5 (a) Life Members;
- ii) Rule 5 (b) Associates of KSCA;
- iii) Rule 5 (c) Cricketer Associates of KSCA, and
- iv) Rule 5 (d) Stand Donor Associates of KSCA.

The above categories shall also be referred as "transferable memberships".

The Rules governing transfer of membership under the above categories shall be as follows:

(a) Upon the death of the member: Upon approval by the KSCA Managing Committee, membership in the Bangalore Sports Centre under the above "transferable category", maybe transferred to the deceased member's

- Spouse or to the deceased member's son / daughter, in the same category as that of the deceased member, excepting in case of Life member who's membership shall be transferred in the category of ordinary member.
- (b) During his or her life time, if a Life Member of KSCA transfers his membership in KSCA to his spouse/son/daughter, then he / she has to compulsorily transfer their membership in Sports Centre as well and the said spouse/son/daughter will be admitted as an Ordinary member of the Sports Centre. Similarly, if an Associate, Cricketer Associate or Stand Donor Associate of KSCA transfers his Associateship to his Spouse/son/daughter, then he/she has to compulsorily transfer his membership in Sports Centre as well and the Spouse/Son/Daughter will be an Ordinary Member of the Sports Centre. The transfer shall be governed by the rules of KSCA By-law.
- (c) In case, the deceased/Transferor Member of KSCA was not a member of Sports centre, then the spouse/son/daughter would not be eligible to become a member of the Sports Centre. If the spouse/son /daughter desires to become a member of Sports Centre, he/she shall have to pay an additional sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) and would be admitted as an Ordinary Member of the Sports Centre
- (d) In case, the deceased/Transferor Associate of KSCA was not a member of Sports Centre, then the spouse/son/daughter would not be eligible to become a member of the Sports Centre. If the spouse/son/daughter desires to become a member of the Sports Centre he/she shall have to pay an additional sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) and would

be admitted as an Ordinary Member of the Sports Centre.

- (e) Members are not permitted to transfer their membership to person other than their spouse/son/daughter.
- (f) Special members are not eligible to transfer their membership of Sports Centre during their life time. The Special Membership is also not transferable after the death of Special Member. The membership ceases on the death or resignation of the concerned member.

Provided however the spouse of special member enrolled under children category, Ranji Players or Ranji umpire's category may be enrolled as a 'special member on the death of such original special member. On the death of the transferee spouse the membership is not further transferable and membership shall cease forthwith.

(C) TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

(1) By Resignation or by operation of Law or on death: -

The membership under any category shall stand terminated on the occurrence of the following events:

(a) Resignation - A member desiring to resign from the membership of the Sports Centre shall inform the Assistant Secretary of the Sports Centre in writing, under acknowledgement and the Committee may accept the resignation provided no amount whatsoever is due to the Sports Centre from the Member. The membership shall stand terminated on acceptance of members letter of resignation by the Committee and on payment of all dues due by the member of the Sports Centre.

(b) If adjudged as an insolvent.

Provided, where the debts of the member are paid in full, the Committee may reinstate such a member on his producing satisfactory proof of such debts.

- (c) If found guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude.
- (d) On death, in case of non-transferable categories of membership.

(2) Mis Conduct/Non-compliance of by-laws:-

If any member refuses or neglects to comply with any provision of the rules or any By-law or is found guilty of having flouted the Rules and / By-law by his / her own conduct, and the Committee is of the view that such conduct is likely to endanger the harmony or interest of the Sports Centre, then such member shall be removed from the membership of the Sports Centre by a resolution of the Committee, as per the procedure prescribed hereunder:

- (a) Upon receiving a complaint in writing from any person interested or aggrieved by the conduct of a alleged, delinquent member and at least 10 days before the meeting at which such a resolution is proposed to be adopted, the concerned member shall be served with a notice, calling to show cause as to why his membership should not be removed.
- (b) The concerned member shall be given 7days' time to submit reply, either in writing or in person;
- (c) It shall be in the powers of the Committee to suspend such a member from the Sports Centre until such time the enquiry into his or her guilt is complete;

- (d) till such time a decision is made by the Committee and a resolution is passed, the member involved shall forthwith cease to be a member of the Sports Centre and shall not have any claim against the Committee or the Sports Centre;
- (e) any fee or a subscription paid shall not be refunded.

(3) Non-payment of dues: -

All members shall pay all their dues fully for each calendar month on or before the 20^{th} of the succeeding month. If any member fails to pay his / her dues including rent and /or compensation in respect of any part of the Sports Centre's property in his use or occupation or subscription or bills to the Sports Centre

- (a) A notice shall be issued in writing demanding outstanding dues from such member, calling upon the member to clear the outstanding amount within a period of 7 days from the receipt of notice;
- (b) In addition to the service of notice, the name of the member shall be published on the notice board for a period of 30 days as a defaulter and notice of such posting shall be sent to the member by mail or Register Post to the last known e-Mail ID/address.
- (c) Non-receipt of the bills shall not be considered as an excuse for non-payment of bills.
- (d) If, on the expiry of thirty days, the amount due or any part thereof remains unpaid, the member shall cease to be a member of the Sports Centre and his name shall be forthwith removed from the Register of Members.
- (e) The Committee shall have the powers to take necessary steps to recover dues from the members.
- (f) Once such member clears all his dues and makes an application for re-admission, such defaulting member

may be readmitted without formal re-election as follows:

- (i) Readmission charges shall be Rs.5,000/- in addition to the dues up to the date of application, if the application is made within twelve months from the date of termination.
- (ii) If the application is made after the twelve months, the readmission fee will be the rate of admission as on the date of application, in addition to the subscription falling due as on the date of application.
- (iii) Re-admission for a defaulted Member (Life Member/ Associate) shall be Rs.50,000/- + dues + penalty etc.
- (g) No member whose name is published as a defaulter shall be entitled to any of the privileges of membership.
- (h) No member who has been notified as a defaulter twice shall be admitted as a Member, even if the dues are cleared by such a member.
- (i) A defaulting member cannot cast his / her vote, until the default has been set right, and the name of the defaulting member is removed from the list of defaulters.
- (j) A vote cast by a defaulting member is null and void.

(4) Disciplinary Actions and/or Suspension of Members:

- (a) If the conduct of any member, guest or/and any affiliated Club Member using the Sports Centre and in the premises of the Sports Centre:
 - i. is found injurious to the reputation of the Sports Centre.

- ii. Such as to disturb the order, peace and harmony of the Sports Centre.
- iii. A source of disturbance and annoyance to other users of the Sports Centre.
- iv. Is found to be in the nature of disrespecting and/or flouting the authority of the officials of the Sports Centre.
- v. A violation or wilful infraction of the rules and regulation and By-law of the Sports Centre and / KSCA;
 - Then, the Hon. Assistant Secretary in consultation with the Chairman and Hon. Secretary of KSCA may proceed to suspend such a member.
- vi. Upon the commission of offending conduct, incidents or events or upon the receipt of a complaint in that regard, the Assistant Secretary shall take immediate cognizance and call for an explanation from the concerned member and report the matter to the Executive Committee.
- vii. The Executive Committee thereupon shall institute the necessary enquiry and if after the enquiry, the Committee concludes that, the concerned member has acted in the manner stated above, it shall take suitable action by administering a suitable warning or suspending the member for a temporary period. If the Executive Committee considers it necessary to terminate the membership of such a member the proposal should then be submitted for consideration to the Managing Committee of KSCA.
- viii.Pending an enquiry, in the event of misuse of the Sports Centre as stated in Rule 10(D)(2), such membership shall stand suspended. After a due

- enquiry, the Executive Committee may suspend a member for a maximum period of 3 months. In such a scenario, the suspension already undergone by the member at the stage of enquiry shall also be treated as suspension for purpose of punishment.
- ix. The Executive Committee shall have the power to suspend a member for a maximum of 2 terms of 3 months each. Thereafter the Executive Committee may recommend the name of such member for removal from the rolls of the membership of the Sports Centre to the Managing Committee of the K.S.C.A.
- (b) If the offending member is a member of any other affiliated club or any other sports centre, such member may be warned or suspended from using the Sports Centre for a specific period and the same shall be notified to the concerned club/Sports centre.
- (c) If the offending member is a guest, then such guest shall not be allowed to enter the Sports Centre as any one's guest for a minimum period of 3 months and the member who hosted him shall be warned.
- (d) Any member suspended from the Sports Centre the above rules will not be allowed to enter the area of the Sports Centre even as a guest of another member. However, there will be no suspensions of fees and subscriptions payable by him.
- (e) Any member dealt under the above rules shall have the right to appeal to the Managing Committee of KSCA within TEN DAYS of receiving the order of suspension. Pending decision of the Managing Committee the suspension order however will continue.

11. ADMISSION FEES AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

(A) ADMISSION FEES

- (a) The fee payable for admission for different category of membership shall be as prescribed by the Managing Committee and approved by the General Body of KSCA and as laid out in **Schedule II.**
- (b) Managing Committee shall publish the latest updated fee structure as applicable from time to time and shall publish the same on the website / make it available at the office of the Sports Centre.
- (c) Individual who have become Associates of KSCA by paying an amount of **Rs.1,00,000**/- or above specified in KSCA By-law need not pay any amount for the admission of the Sports Centre.
- (d) Categories specified in Rule 11 are governed by the rules of KSCA regarding payment of admission fee as per KSCA rules. No separate amount other than payable as per KSCA rules are required to paid for the Sports Centre and hence the admission fee is shown as nil.
- (e) If a Stand Donor opts to become a Member of KSCA without taking benefit of the privileges associated with the Bangalore Sports Centre and subsequently desires to become a Member of the Bangalore sports centre, then he shall be treated as an Associate and he shall have to pay a sum of **Rs.50,000/-** as per Rule 11 (ii).

(B) SUBSCRIPTIONS:

(1) Monthly Subscriptions for the Bangalore Sports Centre:

Until and unless, specifically exempted as per sub-rule (2) hereunder, the members of the Bangalore sports Centre shall pay the following monthly Subscriptions for the Bangalore Sports Centre and the such

subscription so paid by the members shall entitle the spouse of such member also to use the facilities of the Sports Centre as is applicable to the member concerned. However, the spouse of the member shall not be entitled to attend the meeting or to vote in the elections.

- (a) Ordinary Members, Special Members and Corporate Members shall pay a monthly subscription of Rs. 175/- (Rupees One hundred Seventy Five only).
- (b) The monthly subscription of dependent members will be Rs.50/- (Rupees Fifty per dependent).
- (c) Residential Rooms shall be as decided by the Managing Committee of KSCA, from time to time, which shall be notified/published at the residential rooms section and available at the office of the Sports Centre.
- (d) The subscription fee for the LTTM shall be double the ordinary subscription per month and the same will be collected in advance for the full period of three years.
- (e) The subscription fee for Service Members shall be Rs.175/- (Rupees One hundred Seventy Five only) per month and will be collected in advance for the full period of two years.
- (2) Subscriptions to individual sections of the Bangalore Sports Centre: -

In addition to the above monthly subscription, various games will have separate fees, both monthly and/or for each games / facility fees as the case may be. These facilities shall be referred to as "sections". Members opting to use such sections / facilities shall pay the prescribed fees according to rules.

- i. New Members opting for such facilities / section will automatically be charged the prescribed monthly fees for the section / game opted for a minimum period of six months. However, to use the Swimming pool section, the minimum period of subscription shall be 12 months. If the members do not wish to continue they may resign from the section with a resignation letter to be acknowledged duly by the Office. However, spouses of deceased members who avail membership by transfer and are 65 years of age or more shall be exempted from opting for the mandatory two section's subscriptions.
- ii. Any Member opting for any section / facility shall pay a minimum of six months fee to start with. Later they will have option to withdraw from such sections by a letter of resignation. (No monthly memberships or part withdrawals will be permitted).
- iii. Members of the Sports Centre shall have free access to the Sports Centre during working hours; however they shall pay necessary fees for all the categories of the Games/facilities and shall abide by any restrictions that may be imposed during the pendency of all or any other Tournament of such games.
- (3) Exemption from payment of Subscriptions: -
 - (a) Life Members of the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be exempted from paying monthly subscriptions.
 - (b) Ordinary Members of the Sports Centre, who have 25 years standing as Life Member of KSCA or Associates of KSCA and have been member of the Sports Centre for a continuous period of 20 years and have attained the age of 65 years shall also be

exempted from payment of the monthly subscription as above, at their option (This provision is effective from 01.01.2000).

Note:- For the purposes of this clause, for reckoning the period of 20 years membership in the sports centre, in the case of KSCA Associates (who get KSCA Associateship in lieu of their membership standing in KSCA Club House / Bangalore Sports Centre) and who continue their membership of Bangalore Sports Centre under any other category and are 65 years and above shall also be covered.

- (c) Spouse members of deceased member of Bangalore Sports Centre, who get the membership transferred on the death of the member and who are 65 years and above shall also be exempted from payment of Monthly subscription charges, provided such member cumulatively along with their deceased spouse have completed 25 years in KSCA as Life member / Associate and 20 years in the KSCA Clubhouse / Bangalore sports centre.
- (d) The subscription for Short Term Temporary Members shall be nil.
- (4) The Managing Committee of KSCA reserves the right to alter the structure of admissions fees and various subscriptions from time to time at its discretion.

CHAPTER FOUR GOVERNANCE AND ELECTIONS

12. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

vii. Nominated Members

(A) The activities of the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be managed by an Executive Committee which shall comprise of the following:

i. President - President of KSCA

ii. Chairman - Vice Presidents of KSCA

iii. Hon Secretary - Hon Secretary of KSCA

iv. Hon. Treasurer - Hon. Treasurer of KSCA

v. Hon. Joint Secretary - Hon. Joint Secretary

vi. Elected members - Eight members elect

- Eight members elected amongst the Members of the Bangalore Sports Centre, who are qualified and eligible to contest for

- Two members nominated

Executive Committee,.

amongst the Members of the managing committee of KSCA, one of whom shall be the Assistant Secretary of the Bangalore Sports Centre; One lady member nominated from, amongst

the members or wife of a member of the Bangalore

sports centre;

- (B) Assistant Secretary shall be the Convenor of the Bangalore Sports Centre Sub-Committee.
- (C) All decisions of the Executive Committee on matter connected with the Bangalore Sports Centre are subject to approval and ratification by the KSCA Managing Committee.
- (D) Any vacancy arising among the Executive Committee may be filled by the KSCA Managing Committee, by nomination.
- (E) Financial management of the Bangalore Sports Centre rests with the KSCA Managing Committee.
- (F) In all matters connected to the Bangalore Sports Centre, the decision of the Managing Committee of KSCA is final.
- (G) Resolutions of all the various committees shall be subject to approval by the Managing Committee of the KSCA. However, the Assistant Secretary may implement urgent and necessary provisions of any resolution in consultation with the Chairman and Honorary Secretary, pending ratification of the Executive Committee of the KSCA.
- (H) Any matter in relation to the members of the Sports Centre or the administration of the Centre per se, is not covered by these rules, the Executive Committee of the Sports Centre shall follow the applicable rules or convention as prevalent in KSCA.
- (I) Qualifications and Disqualifications of the members of the Executive Committee:

i. QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:-

a. The Life Members and Ordinary Members of the Bangalore Sports Centre, whose names are appearing in the register of members of the Bangalore Sports Centre and who do not suffer from any legal disabilities and subject to the other conditions and restrictions contained hereunder shall be eligible to be elected as Executive Committee member of the Bangalore Sports Centre

Explanation: For the purposes of this clause "Ordinary member" shall also include "Special Member (other than nominees of Institutional Member / Institutional Associates)" of the Bangalore Sports Centre;

Note: - The cut-off date for being on the rolls / records of the association shall be reckoned as on at least one month prior to the date of the notice to be issued by the Assistant Secretary of the Bangalore Sports Centre for the Annual meeting.

b. Any person to be nominated by the KSCA Managing Committee shall be a member of the Bangalore Sports Centre hailing from Karnataka and shall not suffer from any legal disabilities and shall be subject to disqualifications stated hereunder.

ii. DISQUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

A person shall be disqualified from being a member of the Executive Committee, either elected or nominated if he or she:

- (a) is not a citizen of India;
- (b) has attained the age of 70 years;
- (c) is declared to be insolvent, or of unsound mind;
- (d) is a Minister or a Government Servant or holds public office;

- (e) has been an Executive committee Member, either as an elected member or as a nominated member of KSCA Club House / Bangalore sports centre for a cumulative period of "9 years".
- (f) Each of the elected member of the Executive Committee shall have a term of 3 years in office, subject to a maximum of 3 terms on the Executive Committee. An elected Executive Committee or a nominated Executive committee member, who has served for two consecutive terms either in the Bangalore Sports Centre or in KSCA (or a combination of both) shall not be eligible to contest any further election without completing a cooling off period of three years. During the cooling off period, such a person shall not be a member of the Executive Committee or of any committee whatsoever of the Bangalore Sports Centre.
- (g) has been charged by a Court of Law for having committed any criminal offence, i.e. an order framing charges has been passed by a court of law having competent jurisdiction; or
- (h) If he / she has been an office bearer or a member of the managing committee (elected / nominated / representative of the Founder Institutional member) of KSCA for a cumulative period of 9 years.

13. ELECTIONS AND TERM OF OFFICE: -

- (a) The election to the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be conducted once in three years and the elected members of the executive committee shall be in office for one term of three years;
- (b) No Nominated Executive Committee Member shall have more than one term of three years and their term shall be co-

- terminus with that of the Executive committee which is in place.
- (c) The nominations for the elections shall not be valid until and unless that is accompanied by the consent of the nominated member/s in the prescribed format. If there are more nominations than the required number to be elected, the election shall be by ballot / Electronic voting. The management would make efforts to conduct the elections within three months from the date of the KSCA elections.

14. POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

- a) Powers & Responsibilities of the Executive Committee: To manage and control the Bangalore Sports Centre in regard to maintenance, catering and general up-keep.
- b) To maintain a library of books and periodicals on Sports and to subscribe to Journals and Books of General Interest.
- c) To organize, promote and afford facilities within the Sports centre premises for any form of games (other than Cricket) and to frame rules thereof.
- d) To use and allow the use of the Sports centre for recreation, sporting events, entertainment and for holding meetings, conferences etc., by the members of the Sports Centre or their guests as permitted.
- e) To suspend a member from the Sports Centre or exclude him from entering or making use of any part of the Sports Centre for such period as the committee may in its discretion determine.
- f) To appoint sub/Committee for various sections and other purposes for efficient functioning of the Sports Centre.
- g) To maintain an up to date list of the members of the Sports Centre together with their addresses.

- h) To prohibit the use of all or any part of the Sports Centre premises by any member who may be indebted to the Sports Centre or who has not adhered to the Rules of the Club or the By-law for the time being in force.
- i) To fill in any casual vacancy on the Committee as per Rule 12(5).
- j) To take such steps to recover dues, subscriptions from members, as the Committee deems fit in the matter.
- k) To make, alter, repeal By-law for the various sections of the Sports Centre.
- 1) To carry out in addition to its above responsibilities such other duties and responsibilities as may from time to time be allotted to it by the Managing Committee of the KSCA.
- m) To recommend to the Managing Committee of KSCA, for appointment of Staff required for the Sports Centre.
- n) The Executive Committee may recommend to the Managing Committee of the KSCA to fill in the vacancy on the Committee under Rule 24.

CHAPTER FIVE: MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION

15. COMMITTEES AND SUB-COMMITTEES:

- a) The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Committee. In the absence of the Chairman, Members present shall elect one of the members to be the Chairman of the Meeting. The Office Bearers of KSCA are ex-officio members of all Committees of the Sports Centre. The Hon. Assistant Secretary is the Convenor.
- b) The Committee shall meet once every month for transaction of the business, unless, an emergency meeting is required to be convened.
- c) Six members present shall form a quorum.
- d) The Assistant Secretary of the Sports Centre may convene an urgent meeting off the Committee on being so requested by the Chairman at the minimum notice of 3 days. For monthly meeting, the Assistant Secretary of the Sports Centre shall send to the members the notice and agenda of the meeting at least 6 (six) days in advance.
- e) Questions arising in any meeting of the Committee shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- f) Any question of resolution considered and decided at a meeting of the Committee shall not be re-opened normally before expiry of six months.
- g) The Committee may appoint sub-committees to conduct the normal activities of the Sports Centre under super-intendence, guidance and control of the Committee. Only members of the Committee shall be Chairman of Sub-Committees and the Assistant Secretary of the Sports Centre shall be the convenor of all such sub-committees.

- h) A sub-Committee shall have no financial powers of expenditure.
- i) A resolution in writing by a Circular signed by all the members of the Committee within the local area at that time shall be as valid and effected as if it had passed at a meeting of the Committee duly called and constituted.
- j) The number of members off a Sub-Committee shall not exceed ten in number excluding the office bearers of the Sports Centre.

16. CEASSATION OF MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE

A member of a Committee or Sub-Committee shall cease to be a member thereof, if he/she:

- a. Absents himself / herself from attending 3 (three) consecutive meetings of the Committee without obtaining leave of absence from the Committee.
- b. If he is convicted by a court of law for any offence involving moral turpitude.
- c. If he is expelled or suspended from the Association.
- d. If he is absent from the State of Karnataka for a period of six months, without obtaining leave of absence from the Assistant Secretary.

17. MEETING OF MEMBERS:

The Bangalore Sports Centre shall in each year hold its "Annual Sports Centre Day" on or before the end of February each year, and shall be held at the premises of the Bangalore Sports Centre or at any other place within the City of Bangalore as the Committee may determine.

18. MINUTES OF MEETINGS:

(a) The Assistant Secretary of the Sports Centre shall record and maintain Minutes of all proceedings of Committees, Sub-Committees. He / she shall maintain a register which shall contain a fair and correct summary of the proceedings and the said register / minute book shall be kept at Office of the Sports Centre and shall be accessible to the members of the Sports Centre, upon request.

The Chairman of the meeting shall exercise absolute discretion with regard to the inclusion or non-inclusion of any matter in the minutes. The minutes of the meeting signed by the Chairman at which the proceedings took place or by the Chairman of the succeeding meeting shall be conclusive evidence of the proceedings.

- (b) The minutes shall also contain:
 - i. Details of the Sub-Committee meetings.
 - ii. Names of Members present at each meeting and
 - iii. All resolutions adopted or rejected, including a count of votes received for or against a resolution.

19. REGISTER OF MEMBERS:

- a) Register of members shall be kept in which shall be set forth the name, address and class of membership of every member of the Sports Centre for the time being in which all changes in membership and address from time to time taking place, shall be recorded.
- b) On a request made in writing by a member, a copy of the list of members shall be supplied to him on payment of the price fixed by the Committee from time to time.
- c) Copies of Sports Centre Rules and By-law made hereunder shall be supplied free of charge to the member on his Admission. However, on a request made in writing by a member additional copies will be supplied to him on payment of a price fixed by Committee from time to time.

20. BOOKS AND DOCUMENTS:

- (a) The Committee shall cause to be kept proper books of accounts with respect to all sums of money received and expended by the Sports Centre and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditures take place, of all sales and purchases of goods by the Sports Centre.
- (b) The books of accounts shall be kept at the Office of the Sports Centre or at such other place as Committee may think fit.

21. ACCOUNTS OF THE BANGALORE SPORTS CENTRE:

The Committee shall from time to time cause to be prepared Income and Expenditure accounts of the Sports Centre, with report of the Auditor of KSCA. Such reports should be verified by the Executive Committee at least once in three months.

CHAPTER SIX MISCELLENEAOUS

22. DOCUMENTS AND NOTICES:

- (a) A document or notice may be served on or given by the Bangalore Sports Centre on any member either personally or by sending it by post to him to his registered address as per the register of members maintained by the Bangalore Sports Centre.
- (b) Any document or notice to be served / given by the Sports Centre may be signed by the Assistant Secretary of Bangalore Sports Centre or the Honourable Secretary of the KSCA on in their absence by some person duly authorized by the Committee for such purpose and the signature thereto may be written printed or lithographed.
- (c) All documents or notices to be served or given by Members to the Sports Centre shall be addressed to the Assistant Secretary of the Sports Centre and served or delivered at the Registered address of the Sports Centre or sent by Registered Post.

23. OTHER SPORTS CENTRES OF KSCA AND AFFILIATED CLUBS:

(a) OTHER SPORTS CENTRES OF KSCA

The Managing Committee of KSCA, as empowered under Rule 15 (xx) of the KSCA by-laws has powers to run sports centres across Karnataka and also make suitable rules for reciprocal arrangement between all the KSCA sports centres. Thus, in exercise of these powers, the following rules are promulgated:

(1) Membership for each of the Sports centres shall be independent and mutually exclusive;

- (2) "Affiliates", spouse of Affiliates and their dependents of the Alur Sports Centre shall be allowed to use the facilities of the Bangalore Sports Centre, at par with the members of the Bangalore Sports Centre for up to a maximum of 7 days in a month, on payment of charges / fees as applicable to the facilities they use;
- (3) Subject to clause (1) above, any member of any other KSCA sports centre desiring to use the facilities of the Bangalore Sports Centre shall be governed by the rules as applicable to "AFFILIATED CLUBS".

(b) AFFILIATED CLUBS

- i The Executive Committee may allow affiliation to any other Club in India or Abroad of comparable standards and facilities with the Sports Centre on a reciprocal basis subject to the rules as laid out hereunder:
- ii. The Members of such clubs shall have the privilege of using the facilities of the Bangalore Sports Centre under such terms and conditions as the Executive Committee stipulates from time to time.
- iii. No member of an affiliated Club shall be entitled to use the Sports Centre and/or Rooms for more than 10 days in a month.
- iv. No affiliated Club Member can host a party or book any party hall in the Bangalore Sports Centre, in his own name in the Sports Centre.
- v. Members of affiliated Clubs on admission shall produce current/valid identity card or letter of introduction from their own Clubs, and shall enter their Club in the guest register at the Reception Counter.
- vi. Affiliated Club Members will have to purchase coupons against a card on or cash payment for settlement of all their bills.

- vii. Infraction and violation of rules and regulations of the Bangalore Sports Centre on the part of the members of affiliated Clubs will entail disciplinary action in the first instance by the Honorary Assistant Secretary with a due report to the affiliated Club concerned, including suspension from use of facilities for such period as may be deemed warranted.
- viii. All the rules and regulations of Bangalore Sports Centre for the time being in force shall be applicable to the Affiliated club members who are permitted to use the facilities of the Sports Centre.

24. ALTERATION, AMENDMENTS, ADDITIONS TO RULES AND BY-LAW:

Any alteration and/or addition and or/or amendments to the rules shall be made by the executive Committee of the Bangalore Sports Centre; those amendments shall be placed by the KSCA Managing Committee in the Annual General Meeting of KSCA for approval.

25. RESIDENTIAL ROOMS:

- a) KSCA has built and furnished double rooms at present which are available for the use of its members and guests as well as affiliated Club Members.
- b) The rooms may be booked on payment of advance money by a member of KSCA for his guest. Non-resident members are entitled to book the rooms for their guest who are not residents of Bangalore City.
- c) No members residing in the City of Bangalore can book the room for himself nor can he stay in the rooms booked in the names of guests. No local member is allowed to stay in the rooms after the closing of Sports Centre hours.

- i. No guest can stay in the rooms for more than 10 (ten) days, continuously. However, if the rooms are vacant they may be permitted to stay with the permission of the Hon Secretary or Assistant Secretary, for an additional period of seven days.
- ii. Guests and members staying in the rooms are all bound by the rules and By-law of the KSCA Sports Centre. Unauthorized use of guest rooms or illegal activities in the guest rooms shall result in immediate expulsion of the concerned member/guest and further disciplinary measures against the concerned member/guest.
- iii. KSCA reserves the absolute rights to reject the residential rooms facility to any member/guest without assigning any reasons.
- iv. The Tariff of the Residential Rooms is fixed from time to time and members/guests shall pay the prevailing rates at the time of their occupancy.

26. DISSOLUTION:

- a) If upon winding up or dissolution of the Sports Centre, if there shall remain after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever the same shall be not be paid to or distributed amongst the Members of the Sports Centre, but shall revert to the KSCA.
- b) In all the affairs of the Sports Centre the decision of the Managing Committee of the KSCA shall be final and binding and no member of the Sports Centre shall have the right of recourse to a Court of law.




